Hi,

A post contest report for the HELVETIA contest RTC service:

The RTC service for the contest ran very smoothly. We didn't encounter any issues, and the results look good. As agreed, the log check results and the public release of all logs are on hold until May 4.

There are 33 online logs

We have received and processed 7423 QSO entries

There are 1857 distinct callsigns in all logs

We received some feedback from online participants asking about discrepancies between the score column on the RTC board and the logger. We explained how RTC real-time adjudication works.

Here is the explanation we provided:

While a contest is active we display on the RTC board the score based on continuous log checking.

This process runs constantly and recalculates everyone's log whenever new QSO data is uploaded by online participants.

In the HELVETIA contest, we see a noticeable number of UNIQUE QSOs, contacts with stations that are not present in other online logs.

These QSOs are considered invalid and do not count toward multipliers. That was the main impact on everyone's online score.

There are also other errors - wrong exchange, wrong call, wrong time etc. Usually they produce a minor impact.
